H1N1 Influenza Clinics for Children Ages 2, 3 and 4

The Bristol-Burlington Health District (BBHD) will be offering an H1N1 (formerly called "Swine Flu") Vaccination Clinic for healthy children, ages 2 years (24 months) through 4 years (48 months) on Tuesday, October 20, 2009 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, October 21, 2009 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.

NO WALK INS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

The Health District in accordance with the Connecticut Department of Public Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will be offering the intranasal vaccine to healthy children 2-4, who are at greater risk for severe illness if they contract the H1N1 or the so-called swine flu. This is a weakened live virus vaccine given in the nose. Pregnant women are not eligible for this live vaccine.

Appointments can be made by calling the Bristol-Burlington Health District office at (860) 584-7682 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. You should plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment. The vaccine will be provided for Bristol and Burlington residents ONLY. Proof of residency will be required. The vaccine will be provided by registered nurses and is free of charge.

For your child to be eligible for this vaccine, they must be 2, 3, or 4 years of age, with no underlying chronic conditions, received no vaccinations (immunizations) within the past 30 days or on antiviral medications 48 hours prior to receiving this vaccine.
